



Rules of Play

Parent and Child Tournament

Format:

Modified Texas Scramble – Only parents will tee off on one designated hole and only the children will tee off on another designated hole.

Competitors will scramble for the remainder of each hole. Both players will tee off on all holes not designated and select the best tee shot for each shot thereafter until completion of the hole.

Age Group Yardages:

Yardages for players and Parents/Guardians will be available the day of the event.

Awards:

Trophies will be presented to the 1st place teams in each age group and everyone will receive medals.

Tiebreaker:

The Lincs Junior Golf Academy Scorecard Playoff will be used to break ties for all awards. The winner will be determined on the basis of the team score on the last six holes, last three holes and finally the last hole. If the teams are still tied, continue backward from the last hole until a winner is determined. (The "last six holes, last three etc." is considered to be 4 - 9, 7 - 9, etc.)

Texas Scramble Format:

- Both players will tee off on all holes not designated on the day.
- Players will choose the best positioned stroke at all times.
- Once a golf ball is "holed out" that is the hole completed, the other player does not have the opportunity to play.
- Please mark the position of the ball to be used and the ball
- may be placed within six inches of the marker for the second player to play their shot.
- Rules of golf apply at all times.
